




Display data in columns and rows

TABLE structure

- TABLE is made of 3 parts
- Column definition (coldefs)
 - Basic properties for columns
- Head section
 - Heading rows
- Body section
 - Body rows







Specific properties (1)

TABLE properties

- Rule
 - Line between 2 columns/rows
- Border
 - Border line around the TABLE
- Padding
 - Space between cell boundary and value contained within








Specific properties (2)

- Column properties
 - Padding
 - For the cells of a column
 - Width
 - Alignment
- Cell properties
 - Padding
 - Alignment
 - Column span
 - Merge cells

TABLE: Fix triggers

- Place fragments among triggers for proper streaming of data rows
- In structure view
 - Drag'n drop
 - Contextual option 'Repeat selected items on'






TABLE: Add content to column

- Put titles in header row (title row)
- Put data in body row (data row)
- Use relative positioning



 Select data view option 'Create an element based on the document context' to affect appropriate class to the items








TABLE: Merge/split cells

- Multi-select cells in Design or Structure view
- Select contextual option 'Merge Cells' or 'Split Cells'

 Sets property 'Column Span' on the affected cells








TABLE: Add additional items

- From contextual menu in Design or Structure view
- Right-click on row/column to add additional rows/columns
- Right-click on any TABLE item to add additional elements









Modify TABLE size

- Change table width ('X-Size')
 - From property panel



Resize the last column from the right-most border



- Don't change the height ('Y-Size')
 - Height is determined by number of rows




TABLE: Change the width of a column

- Column width can be
 - Proportional: In proportion to other columns
 - Fixed: Absolute size

Proportional Width	0.713085
Fix Width	

- Resize column
 - From design view, dragging the right-most border
 - Sets the Proportional width



From the properties panel, setting 'Proportional Width' or 'Fix Width'



Exercise



- Open the 'Sales' project
- Create a new report design using a TABLE container
 - Use the same fields as in the List report before
- Modify the width of the Table columns to more accurate size
- Center align the data of the first column of the table (display value in the center of the cell)
- Add the 'Rating' column (see previous sample)
- Change padding, border and rules settings on the Table
- Merge the 2 first cells of the Table
